



POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP 2022-2023

The research laboratory led by Martine Hébert aims at assessing the needs of children and adolescents who are victims of sexual abuse, documenting their developmental trajectories and evaluating the services offered to them. Research results contribute to the design of effective intervention approaches that promote the optimal development of youth faced with sexual violence. As part of the current fellowship, the candidate will be asked to: 1) conduct analyses on the explanatory mechanisms involved in the diversity of consequences associated with sexual abuse, 2) participate in the evaluation of the effectiveness of interventions targeting children and adolescents victims of sexual abuse; 3) participate in writing manuscripts for peer-reviewed scientific journals and knowledge transfer tools, and 4) support students in statistical analyses and writing scientific publications.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

- Doctoral degree in a relevant discipline (sexology, psychology, criminology, education, etc.) for less than 3 years or in the process of obtaining it;
- Expertise in the field of sexual abuse;
- Experience in clinical research settings an asset;
- Experience in research and writing scientific articles in the field of sexual violence;
- Highly proficient in statistical software (SPSS, MPlus), trajectory analyses and structural equation modeling;
- Fluent in both French and English (spoken and written).

CONDITIONS OF THE POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

- Duration: 12 months full-time
- Start date: March 1st 2022
- Setting: Department of Sexology, Université du Québec à Montréal
- Salary: Internship contract of \$45,000 CAD
- The candidate will be asked to participate in the Chair's dissemination activities and seminars
